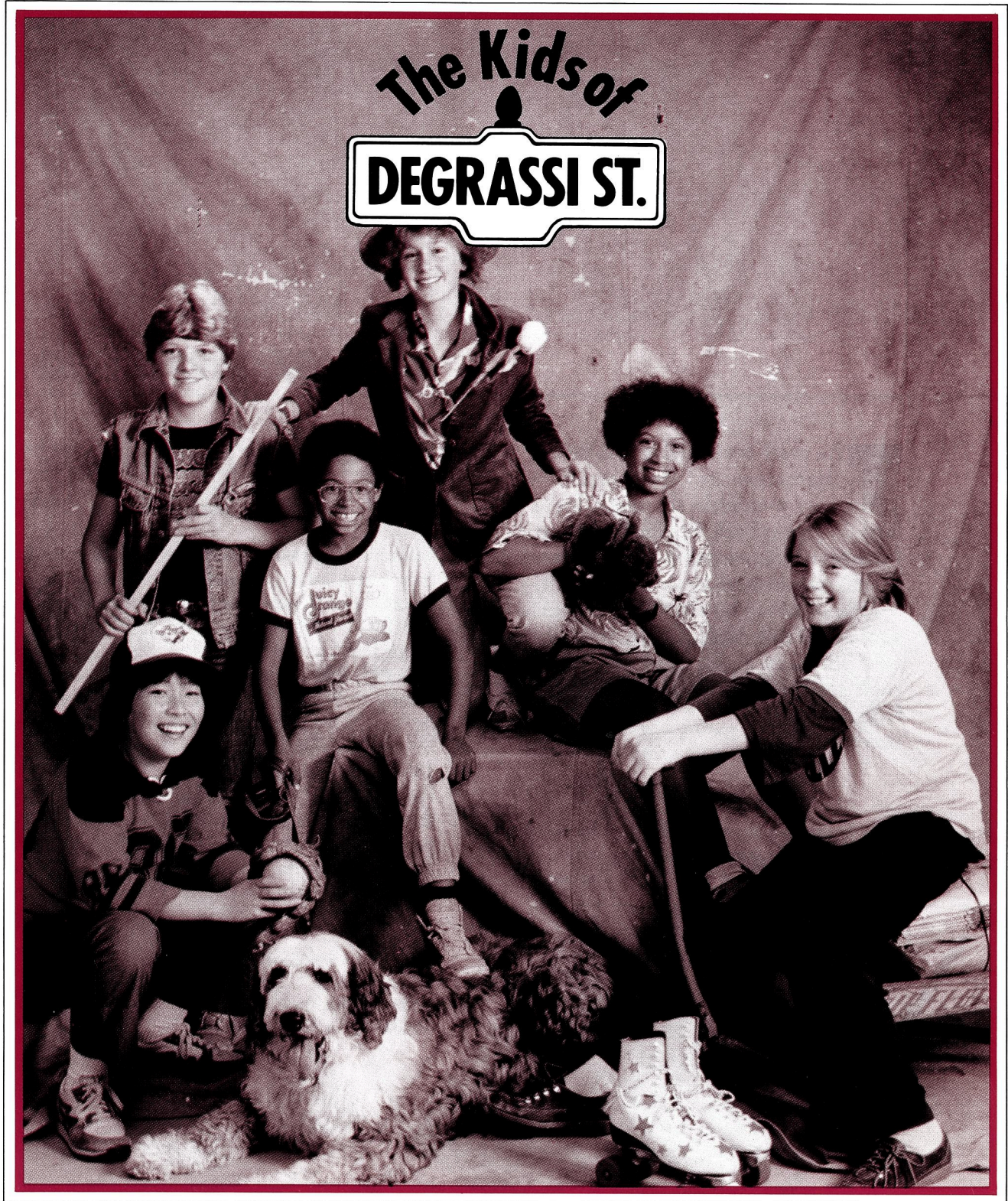

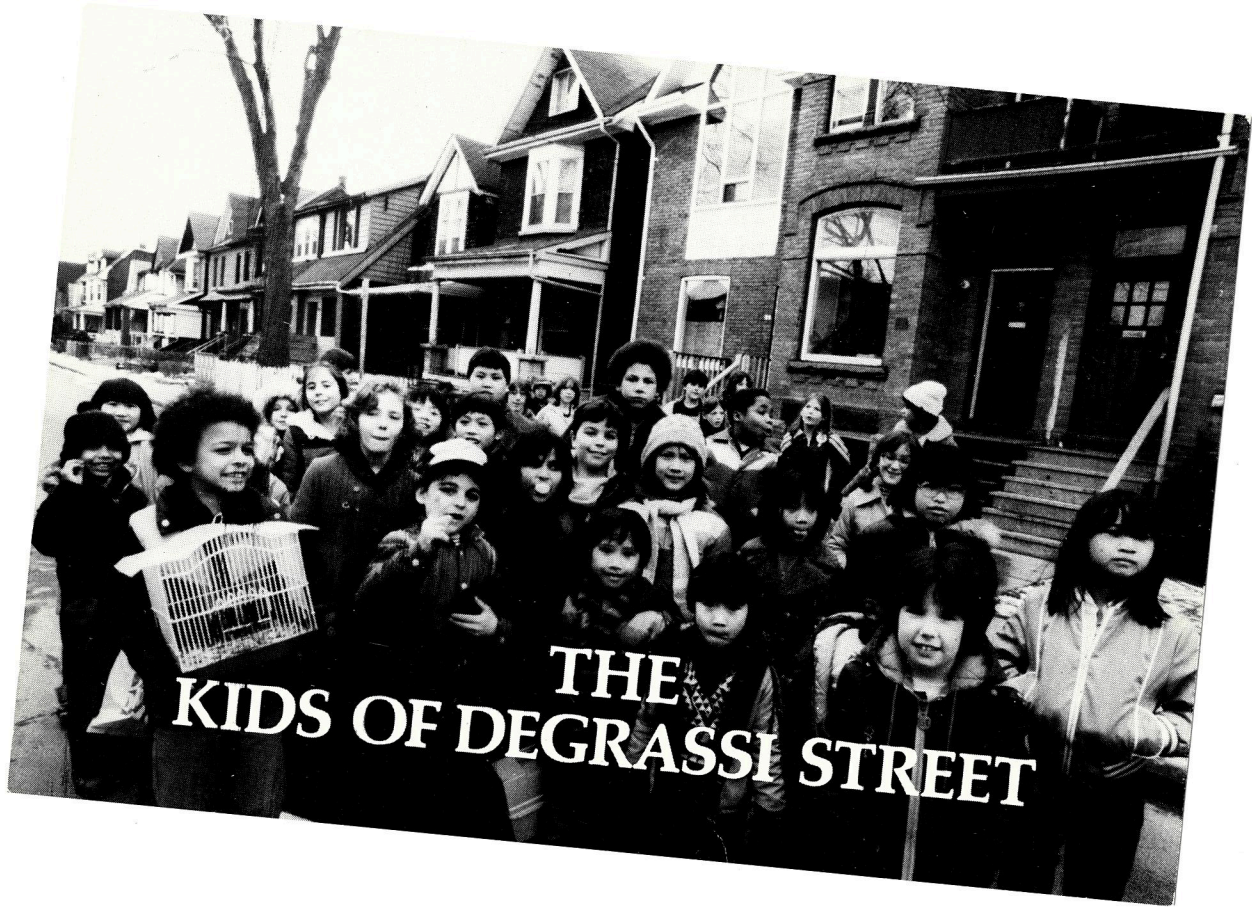
Eve Jennings is an established writer of children's books who has followed the adventures of The Kids of Degrassi Street since the very first episode.
