Our Shooting Crew Equipment Vehicles will arrive on Monday, May 2nd at approx. 9PM. Upon completion of filming, they will depart on Tuesday, May 3rd by 11PM.

During the filming day, we will have film related equipment such as carts, tents, ladders, bins, cables, lighting stands, and more along sidewalks, curb lanes, pre-arranged private spaces and in **Joel Weeks Park**. Please use extra caution when near any active film set. <u>PLEASE NOTE</u>: Areas of the park, including the basketball courts will be limited during Filming Times noted above. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

There will be **intermittent traffic stoppages** on **Queen St** E (Davies Ave to Munro St) - **Carroll St** (Queen St E to Thompson St) **Thompson St** (Davies Ave to Carroll St) & **Ln W Carroll N Thompson** (Thompson St to Matilda St)

All of our filming & related activities are undertaken under the authority & approval of the City of Toronto Film & Television Office. ANY INTERMITTENT TRAFFIC STOPPAGES/CONTROL will be conducted under the safe supervision of the **Toronto Police Service**.

Our Production vehicles and various pieces of film equipment will be located in the following areas, and times.

- Thompson St (S side) Munroe St to Broadview Ave. May 2nd 7PM to May 3rd11PM CONE May 1st 3PM NO PARKING ON NORTH SIDE. To be kept clear for Fire Lane & Emergency access.
- Thompson St (N Side) Davies Ave to Carroll St May 2nd 7AM to May 3rd 11PM CONE May 1st 3PM
- Carroll St (E & W side) Queen St E to Thompson St May 3rd 7AM to May 3th 9PM CONE May 2nd 3PM
- Davies Ave (E side) Queen St E to Thompson St May 2nd 7AM to May 3rd 11PM CONE May 2nd 7AM
- Queen St E (N side) Davies Ave to Carroll St May 2nd 9AM to May 4th 11AM CONE May 2nd 8AM
- Queen St E (S side) Davies Ave to Hamilton St May 2nd 9PM to May 3rd 4PM CONE May 2nd 6PM
- Matilda (S side) 3 x spaces East of Davies May 3rd 7AM to 10PM
- Lane W Carroll N Thompson Thompson St to Matilda May 3rd 7AM to May 3rd 8PM (approx 1 hr Filming)
