

Dear Riverside Residents & Businesses, You are being delivered this important notice.

On Saturday, June 7th, 2025 from 12pm to 6pm, the Riverside District Business Improvement Area (BIA) will be bringing back the Riverside Eats & Beats Streetfest. Riverside's 10 blocks along Queen Street East from Davies to Empire Avenue will be enlivened with activities, food specials, live music, activations in local parks, and sidewalk sales. Our Sidewalk Sale permit will enable businesses and approved vendors to animate the sidewalk space along Queen Street East from Davies to Empire Avenue on June 7th from 9am-9pm, while maintaining a minimum clearance of 2.13 m from the face of the curb for unimpeded passage of pedestrians. We also have applied for a Noise permit which would enable amplified music to be played during the hours of 12pm-6pm at the Street Closures and Parks noted below.

At no time will Queen Street East be closed to traffic; however, we have permits for five partial street closures and two parks during the festival including (Note: see map at back):

1) Carroll Street Closure

Where: north of Queen East to the south edge of the laneway (laneway will be left clear)
When: June 7th: street closed from 8am-8pm; core event hours from 12pm-6pm, during which time amplified music will be played.

2) Munro Street Closure

Where: north of Queen East to the south edge of the laneway (laneway will be left clear)
When: June 7th: street closed from 8am-8pm; core event hours from 12pm-6pm, during which time amplified music will be played.

3) Broadview Ave Street Closure

Where: south of Queen East to the north edge of the laneway (private parking lot behind 705 Queen E will be blocked with permission of the owner)

When: June 7th: street closed from 6am-8pm; core event hours from 12pm-6pm, during which time amplified music will be played.

4) Saulter Street Closure

Where: south of Queen East to the south edge of the Queen Garden Centre and north edge of June Callwood Way (Garden Centre driveway blocked with permission of the garden centre) When: June 7th: street closed from 8am-8pm; core event hours from 12pm-6pm, during which time amplified music will be played.

5) McGee Street Closure

Where: south of Queen East to the north edge of Graham Place Laneway (laneway will be left clear) When: June 7th: street closed from 8am-8pm; core event hours from 12pm-6pm, during which time amplified music will be played.

6) Riverside Common Park

Where: 657 Queen Street East, south of Queen East

When: June 7th: core event hours from 12pm-6pm, during which time amplified music will be played.

7) Joel Weeks Park

Where: 10 Thompson Street, north of Queen East

When: June 7th: core event hours from 12pm-6pm, during which time amplified music will be played.

The above-noted street closures must be clear of any vehicles during the noted times and any vehicles found within the street closure areas above during these hours will receive a no-cost tow to nearby streets/ areas.


